If you are planning a trip with Wiley's Scuba Locker or on your own to somewhere outside the country you WILL need a Passport. In the past if you were traveling to Baja, Canada or the Bahamas you did not need to carry a passport. Times have changed (Thanks to Osama and 9-11).

As of January 1, 2007 everyone needs a pass port. There is a huge backlog of applications.

In the past the passport process was four to six weeks, I would not count on that now.

I would expect to be a minimum of six weeks now.
